In fact, and under cover of economical layoff "Royal Air Maroc" major airline and employee in Morocco, had simply and formally fired almost all former and actual pilot representatives within AMPL.


The actual union President, past union Presidents, past representatives, past General Secretary... 25 among 65 fired pilots were representatives in the last 10 years.

We believe that this "ethnic cleansing" and the atmosphere of fear generated could seriously harm the level of aviation safety within the airline.

We express our full support to colleagues and fellow pilots suffering consequences of disgraceful management practices.

We urge Royal Air Maroc management to start a new round of healthy negotiations and work hand in hand with pilot representatives in finding innovative solutions to preserve jobs, flight safety for the sake of air transport in the region.
